Your teacher will read the stories to you until you learn how to read. But you can study the pictures. Every picture tells you a wonderful story.


When you learn about God you will love Him more and more. Then, someday you will be happy with Him in heaven.

We pray.




We walk out quietly.

Now, too, Jesus says,


“Let the little children

of the whole world.




Jesus Comes at Mass

of Jesus.




He offers wine.
